Do you notice the particularly expressive and spicy floral notes? It evokes a late-afternoon summer garden bathed in sunshine, where fresh, honey-like aromas of magnolia and lemon verbena mingle with mesmerizing hints of lavender and rosewood.



The palate is deep, chalky, and almost mineral. Can you sense the juicy and velvety texture, the melt-in-the-mouth tannins and blue fruit flavors? The finish is really mouthwatering and flavorsome, isn't it?



The 2025 vintage in Saint-Estèphe stands out for being well-balanced overall in terms of precipitation and temperatures, falling within the fifteen-year average. Generous showers during spring, combined with clay soils served as a natural regulator, allowing the vines to cope well with the summer drought.
